



## **Protection and Security Measures**

**The priority of Ktima Aristi is a safe environment for the children that we host every year in our Summer Camp. The following constitute the protection measures that will be in place during this year's camp:**

Ktima Aristi has a total area of 4 acres. The usable spaces are 2 acres that allow the children to feel free avoiding cohabitation.

The maximum number of participants is 20 children per week, with a maximum of 12 children per group

The use of mask & gloves by all camp support staff is mandatory (Reception, cleaning staff, etc.)

Antiseptic will be provided in all areas of the estate. A daily disinfection of the premises will be held by our certified cleaning service.

Surgical masks will be provided to children and adults in case of an emergency

### **Upon arrival of the child at Ktima Aristi:**

Thermometry before entering the camp site. In case the child's temperature is higher than normal (37.0), he / she will not be allowed to enter the camp and will leave with his / her companion.

Use antiseptic at the reception area before the child enters the camp.

Parents / escorts are barred from entering the camp facilities. The child will be picked up by the camp coordinator and / or nurse at the main entrance. Only children and Camp staff are allowed on site during the day.

### **During the camp:**

Training of all children for the proper observance of the precautionary measures (distances, coughing, sneezing, touching the face, proper use of a mask), with a specially designed program, every Monday, by the Nurse of the Estate.

If a child develops symptoms compatible with COVID-19 (fever 37.5 or older, cough, shortness of breath, diarrhea, fatigue, headache, muscle aches, nausea, loss of taste or anosmia, sore throat, vomiting, etc.), it is transferred to the reception area, where there are masks, gloves and alcohol antiseptic, as well as a nurse. His / Her parents will be informed immediately.

### **Meals - Water:**

Meals are served in groups of 6 and while keeping each group apart from each other. The children's seats will be demarcated and marked with special markings.

It is not allowed to replenish water or ice during the meal. All children must have a large bottle of water with them, with their name written on it. During lunch, an additional plastic bottle of cool water is offered (at no extra charge).
