AUTUMN - WINTER | Wool SPRING | Cotton and linen SUMMER | Silk


They then take part in specially designed experiential games, and the programme ends with a customized construction to take home.

Students learn about the fascinating history of the olive, its importance for our health and the varieties of olive products.

A particularly exciting experience is their participation in the traditional olive harvest, where they experience the process as real olive growers.

They learn about the 'journey' of the olive from the field to the final packaging, and thus become aware of all aspects of the production of this precious gift of nature.

The workshop ends with a fun tasting that they will never forget!










LITTLE FARMERS






Discover the world of agriculture through a unique experience!

Students are guided around the farm, learn the secrets of growing vegetables or aromatic plants and take on the role of little agronomists, creating their own garden.

Through interactive games, students discover the valuable health benefits of vegetables and herbs, while developing a deeper relationship with nature.




















A program dedicated to insects!

Students discover the essential role of solitary bees and other insects in nature, learning about the life cycle, habits, and importance of these pollinating and beneficial insects.

Students become architects themselves as they build their own insect hotels, creating safe spaces for solitary bees and other insects to thrive.

This activity encourages students to protect biodiversity, and to understand the vital connection between insects and healthy ecosystems.









SENSORY GARDEN







Through hands-on games, students discover the unique sounds, colors, textures and tastes of different plants.

A walk around the farm, the sounds and textures of nature come to enhance all the students' senses and the program concludes with a tasting that the students do after collecting herbs and fruits from our farm, deepening their connection with nature.







COMPOSTING WITH GEO



The secrets of composting!

In this program, students explore our living worm farm and learn how earthworms break down organic waste and turn it into nutrient-rich soil.

Through hands-on activities they understand the importance of composting for the environment and the vital role earthworms play in soil conservation.







MUDFARM





Interactive games and mud cooking!

A special space where students get in touch with nature, discovering earthworms, ants and other small creatures in the soil, stimulating curiosity and observation.


They also create imaginative dishes by mixing soil, water, leaves, rocks, and twigs, encouraging the development of sensory awareness and fine motor skills.




